

Pilots and Visitors Information

Euroflugtag 2018

Dates: 10th – 12th August (regularly the second weekend in August)

Location: Niederkassel-Rheidt between Cologne (Köln) and Bonn (former Germany's capital) in the central west of Germany

Show Time: from 10:00 until 18:00 hours scheduled by means of a Slot System

Opening Times: Show open to the public from 10:00 hours until dusk.

Charges: No charges at all, free admission, free parking for Pilots and its Family, free camping; however, donations are welcome.

Models & Fliers: Pilots come from all over Europe for this Show. Model weight limit is a maximum of 150 kg with a German licence.

Flying Field: 300m x 70m; grass and very flat; no obstacles, no trees around the flying area

Model Weights/Regulations:

- German regulations allow models up to 25kg take-off weight (including fuel) without a licence.
- Models over 25kg require a licence from the German Authorities to fly at the Show. For further details please get in touch with the Club.

Insurance: Mandatory

Pits Area: Can be viewed by the public from behind a waist high safety fence

TX Control:

Very well organized and secure;
2,4 GHz (preferably)

Pilots Briefing: In German and English

Commentary: Provided by the club with two speakers in a dialogue

Marshall's/Helpers:

Many of them are at the flight line. They are totally committed to the smooth running of the Show. Most speak English and really want their guests to enjoy themselves.

Facilities: from Wednesday 4th August on

- Toilets, Freshwater, Electricity (european 2-pin plug required).
- Pavilion

Camping:

On site and close to the flight line. Motor homes/Campers/Caravans can arrive from Monday 6th August and depart on Monday 13th August or at any time between the above dates.

Refreshments: 20 free bons per show day are given to pilots and their helpers

- from Thursday 9th August on:
 - Beer and Beverages are provided in the pavilion and at the Beer Stands.
 - Food will be offered in the pavilion.

Breakfast: served from 8:00 until 11:00 hours at the Show (show days only)

Utilities: DRK (Red Cross) are present as well as the local Fire Brigade.

Local Amenities (distances from Show Site):

- Several Hotels are nearby; a list of Hotels is available upon request.
- Petrol Station (2km)
- Supermarket (2km; closed on Sundays)
- Golf Course (1,5km)
- Petrol Station with Supermarket (5km; all days open)
- Cologne/Bonn Airport (10km)
- ICE Train station Siegburg (10km)

Sight seeing (distances from Show Site):

- Cologne (15 km)
- Bonn (10km)
- River Rhein (2km)

Social Events:

- Fri, Sat evening: Come-together in the pavilion and at the bar with music
- Sat 22:30 hours: Firework Display

Trade Stands: Participation will be appreciated (charge 100 Euro for 6x4m).

Getting there

From the autobahn A4

Leave the A4 at **exit 14, keep to the right** and join the A559, signposted **A559 Königswinter/Flughafen Köln-Bonn**.

The A559 almost immediately becomes the **A59**

From the A59

Leave the **A59** at **exit 37** which is signposted **Spich, Spich/Niederkassel**. At the end of the exit/slip road follow the signs for **Niederkassel**. After a few hundred metres you will come to a roundabout, take the **3rd** exit, again signposted **Niederkassel**. Continue on this road for

approximately 1km until you get to another roundabout. Take the **4th** exit, again signposted **Niederkassel**. Continue on this road for 4.5km which will have taken you through the small village of Stockem (**Beware stationary radar trap**) and around the edge of Uckendorf, until you come to another roundabout. Take the **3rd** exit, signposted **Niederkassel/Lülsdorf**. Follow this road for a further 1.7km to the next roundabout, take the **2nd** exit, signposted **Bonn/Niederkassel**. Continue on this road for 1.2km to yet another roundabout and take the **2nd** exit, signposted **Bonn/Rheidt** . Nearly there !!!!! After 1.7km on this road you will be approaching a sharp right hand bend. **DO NOT GO ROUND THE BEND** but turn left at the apex, on to a small farm road. Stay on this farm lane for 1km until you come to the turning to **Die Grosse Heerstrasse**, Turn right into **Die Grosse Heerstrasse**, after 500mtres turn left into **Otto Lilienthal Weg**. You are now at the Show site.

A helpful hint on German Autobahn signs:

The following normally applies.

On nearing an exit (usually 1km from exit) only the **first, overhead** sign shows the exit number.

After that, the **only** indication of what exit number you are approaching, is shown on the "300mtr to exit sign".
